NO ENTRY FEE

1. Entries accepted Friday, August 5, Noon to 7 p.m. and Saturday, August 6, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. **NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER 4:00 PM SATURDAY.** (Upstairs in the Main Pavilion). It is requested that exhibitors MUST BE IN THE DEPARTMENT at least one (1) hour before entries close.
2. It is NOT necessary to pre-enter in crafts. Entry forms are available at the time of entry. (The exception to this rule is collections)
3. Please write the description of your entry on each entry form.
4. **An exhibitor may make only ONE entry in each lot.**
5. All exhibits to be hung must be provided with a secure means for hanging.
6. Space is limited. No cases will be reserved in advance.
7. All entries are shown at the risk of the owner. Reasonable precaution will be taken to insure safety of the exhibits. Some locked display cases will be available. The officials will not be responsible for any losses or damage.
8. All entries must be new or recently made and must represent the hobby or handiwork of the exhibitor. (No bought items)
9. General rules and regulations governing all departments of the Fair apply to this division.
10. Juniors are welcome to compete in any category, but may not compete in similar lots in both Junior and Adult classes.
11. **RELEASE TIME 2:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M Monday after Fair. NO EARLY RELEASES - NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE - NO ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED WITHOUT YOUR CLAIM CHECKS.** Cash premiums will be given out at the Will Call Window starting Wednesday of Fair. Check the office and website for posted times. NO PREMIUMS OR RIBBONS will be mailed.
12. Anything 2 inches or smaller must be individually fixed on a card.
13. Displays of 2 or more pieces must have superintendent's pre-approval.
14. Displays of 2 or more feet must have superintendent's pre-approval. Anyone removing display earlier than release time may have premiums withheld.

- Collections are displayed in Hobby Hall. Entries accepted Friday, August 5, Noon to 7 p.m. and Saturday, August 6, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER 4 P.M. SATURDAY. (Upstairs in the Main pavilion). It is requested that exhibitors **MUST BE IN THE DEPARTMENT** at least one (1) hour before entries close.
- ONE entry per exhibitor
- Collection must be owned by the exhibitor. The same collection can not be shown two years in a row.
- Collection MUST include a brief description on a 5 x 8 card or paper.
- Exhibitor must supply their own display cloth, hanger, racks, blocks, for their display. **Mark each item in collection.**
- All entries are shown at the risk of the owner. Reasonable precaution will be taken to insure safety of the exhibits. Some locked display cases will be available. The officials will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- Collection should contain no less than 5 objects.
- General rules and regulations governing all departments of the Fair apply to this division.
- Judging will be done 50% on educational value; 15% on display; 35% on card.
- Space is limited. No cases will be reserved in advance. You will be given a 1/3 of a case or 24x24" space if possible. Exhibitor must arrange their own entry.
- Collection to be hung **MUST have a hanger**. Must be mounted on a **SECURE** backing no bigger than 24x24" space.
- RELEASE TIME: 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday after the Fair. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE AND NO ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED WITHOUT YOUR CLAIM CHECK.
