ENTRY FEE: \$1.00 per fleece

1. Fleece entries will be judged & displayed in textile department, located upstairs in the Main Pavilion.
2. If entry fee not paid fleece will NOT be judged.
3. **Entries will be accepted until Monday August 15th at 8:00pm. FLEECES MUST BE IN PLACE BY Mon AUGUST 15th, 8:00pm**
4. All fleeces must be a current year clip.
5. All fleeces will be prepared for show (tied with wool twine, skirted to remove less desirable wool, and tied securely.)
6. Fleeces will be pre-entered at \$1.00 per fleece.
7. Fleeces will have an exhibitor provided tag attached stating name and address of owner, the breed represented, and if from a ram, ewe, or wether.
8. Fleeces will be removed Sunday at the close of the Fair.
9. Private sale of show fleeces is permitted; however, fleeces have to stay entire length of show.
10. Limited to two monies per lot.
11. All fleeces MUST have been skirted (removal of all foreign matter, dung locks, and less desirable wool) or entry will be disqualified.
12. Classes may be combined at the discretion of the superintendent.
13. Release time: Entries must be removed Sunday, the last day of the Fair, at 8:00 p.m. Fleeces not picked up will be disposed of.
